Emergency Surcharge (EMS) – Asia-Europe Trade Eastbound

Effective 4th January 2024

Dear valued customer,

due to events in the Red Sea which affect our methods and routes of transportation, vessels to/from Europe will be redirected via Cape of Good Hope for the safety of crew, vessels, and partners.

With effect from 4th January 2024 shipped on board date, OOCL will introduce an Emergency Surcharge (EMS) as per below quantum on all dry, reefer and project cargo until further notice.

- USD 500/ 20'GP & special equipment
- USD 750/ 40'GP/HQ/ 45'HQ & special equipment
- USD1200 per 20'/40' RF/RQ

This Emergency Surcharge (EMS) will apply from Europe to Middle East, Indian Sub-Continent & Far East.

OOCL will continue to monitor the situation closely, with safety and security as our top priority. We will continue to assess the feasibility of various options and will take appropriate measures according to different conditions.
