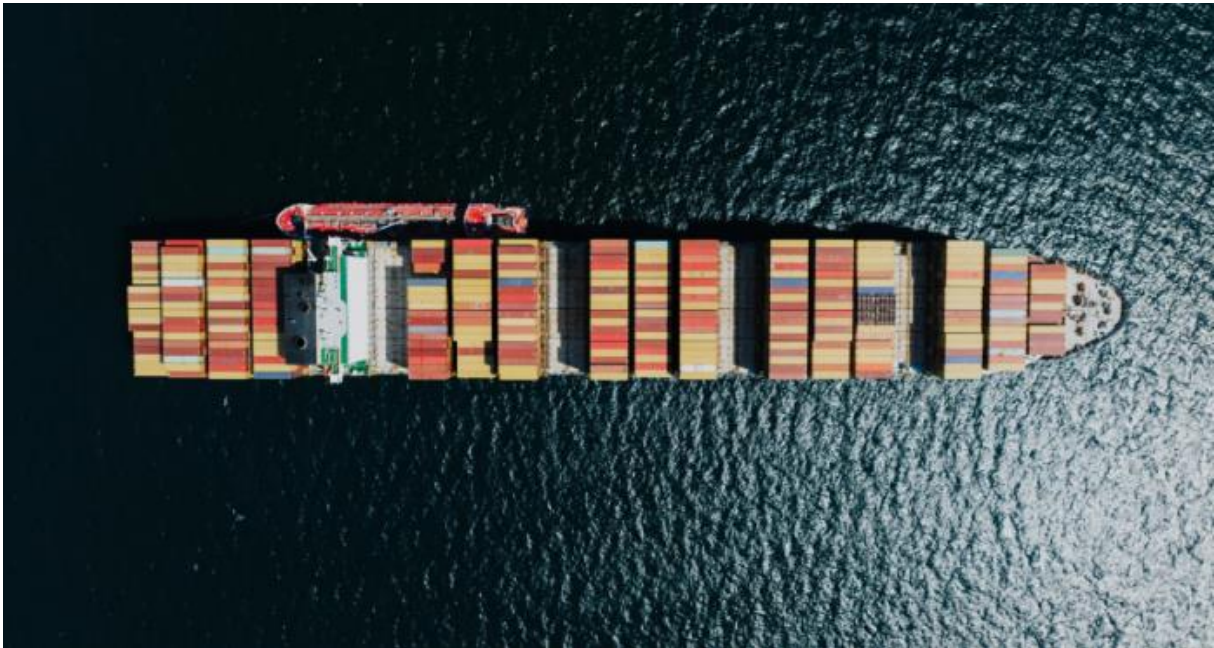


SeaLead expands Mediterranean network with new service
