CBSA Adds to Its List of CARM Bulletins

New Pricing for Digital Negotiable FIATA Multimodal Transport Bill of Lading

FIATA is introducing a simplified, more accessible pricing model for the digital negotiable FIATA multimodal transport bill of lading (eFBL).

Key details of the new pricing model

- Pricing at issuance: A price of CHF 0.50 per eFBL document will be charged to all FIATA members, regardless of the market.
- Fee for amendments: An additional fee of CHF 2.00 for each amendment to the digital record will be charged. This fee covers the administrative cost of replacing the original record secured by blockchain technology.

- Effective date: January 1, 2025

With this updated pricing model, FIATA is looking to encourage a wider adoption of digital tools and lower the barriers to digitalization. FIATA aims to make the eFBL more accessible and appealing to freight forwarders, particularly small and medium-sized enterprises. This initiative empowers them to leverage digital documentation to enhance operational efficiency, expedite handling, maintain data ownership and achieve cost savings.

Transitioning from paper-based processes to digital documentation offers significant benefits, including:

- Enhanced operational efficiency and reduced delays.
- Lower risks of fraud and document tampering.
- Faster and more-secure trade processes.
- Improved supply chain collaboration.
