



Import + Export – Demurrage and Detention Increases

Effective January 21, 2025

Dear Valued CMA CGM Customer,

Due to increased operational costs, CMA CGM (America) LLC is announcing the following changes to its demurrage and detention charges (tariff **CMDU 100 RULES 100, 200, and 300**). These changes will go into effect on **January 21, 2025** and affect the following:

- **Rule 100 – US Import Demurrage Rule:**
 - Increase of demurrage charges for “Standard” containers for “All US Port” (i.e., ports other than those expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule);
 - Increase of certain demurrage charges for port of “New York” for “20’ / 40’ Standard”, “45’ Standard” and “Refrigerated” container types;
 - Increase of demurrage charges and revised tiers for port of “Philadelphia” for “Refrigerated” containers.
- **Rule 200 – Export Demurrage Rules:**
 - Increase of demurrage charges for “DRY” containers for “All US Port” (i.e., ports other than those expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule);
 - Increase of certain demurrage charges for port of “New York” (except for terminals/commodities and/or type of equipment otherwise expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule) for “20’ AND 40’ DRY” and “45’ DRY” container types;
 - Increase of demurrage charges for “Refrigerated” containers for “All US Port” (i.e., ports other than those expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule).
- **Rule 300 – U.S. Detention:**
 - Increase of detention charges for “DRY” containers for “All US Port Export & Import” (i.e., ports other than those expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule);
 - Increase of certain detention charges for “Refrigerated” containers for “All US Port Export & Import” (i.e., ports other than those expressly specified in the relevant tariff rule);
 - Increase of detention charges and revised tiers for “DRY” containers for “California Import.”
