#### Carriers Warn of Cargo Disruption Due to Strikes at Munich Airport

Lufthansa Cargo (LC) has warned customers that strikes by German trade union ver.di on Thursday and Friday at Munich Airport (MUC) will mean its operations will be "significantly limited."

"As a result, it is likely that no cargo will be transported from, to or via, Munich on Lufthansa Group passenger aircraft from Thursday at midnight to Friday at 23:59pm," Lufthansa Cargo warned.

Further, from midday on Wednesday until midnight on Friday, LC has embargoed inbound road feeder services land shipments, temperature-sensitive products, live animals and perishables.

#### **ILA Ratifies 6-Year Labour Contract**

The International Longshoremen's Association voted to ratify a six-year contract agreement with the United States Maritime Alliance on Tuesday, according to a Facebook post shared by the union on Wednesday.

The union, which represents roughly 85,000 longshore workers at 100 seaports across the East and Gulf Coasts, said its members voted nearly 99% in favour to approve the tentative contract agreement that was reached in January.

The ILA said in a statement the contract became retroactively effective on October 1, 2024 and will expire on September 30, 2030. The contract will be formally signed by both the ILA and USMX on March 11.
