

# Road Disruptions in Sindh

Dear Valued Customers and Partners,

This is to update that there is still no sign of the strike ending and containers are still unable to reach Karachi Port from ICD's, not to mention, operations in Karachi are still unaffected and container movement is not facing any delays.

Official negotiations still haven't started between the gov committee and protestors, and it's expected that if the strike continues for a few more days, it could lead to overwhelming effects on logistics.

Hundreds of perishable containers are stuck at the entry point of Sindh (Port Province/State) and are unable to reach the port for loading, this could result in order cancellations and significant export losses, especially for temperature-sensitive goods.

Additionally, over 800 oil tankers are reportedly stuck because of strike, which could lead to fuel shortages in upcountry areas.

We will continue to monitor the situation and will keep you posted.
