Ban applied by both Indian & Pakistan Government on commercial shipping - 4th Update

Dear Valued Customers and Partners,

We would like to keep you informed about the evolving situation between Pakistan and India, and its potential impact on logistics and supply chains in the region. As shared earlier, India conducted strikes within Pakistani territory this morning, which led to a temporary closure of Pakistan's airspace.

Air Freight:

While the airspace has since reopened with restrictions, some flights have been cancelled or rescheduled. Most airlines have now resumed cargo acceptance, though we advise checking with our team for specific routes and carriers.

Ocean Freight:

As previously communicated:

MSC and CMA CGM have re-routed their Europe and East Coast U.S. cargoes via Colombo and Khalifa Port.

Hapag-Lloyd and Maersk remain unaffected and continue to route cargo through Salalah.

Most carriers have suspended direct calls from Pakistan to Europe and East coast, opting instead to continue those direct services to India. Pakistan cargo will now be connected via feeders through Colombo, Khalifa, or Salalah.

While operations are gradually returning to normal, we remain vigilant and continue to plan with caution to ensure minimal disruption to your cargo flows.
