Shipping from Asia to Latin America? A GRI is coming up

A **General Rate Increase (GRI)** from Asia to the West Coast of South America, East Coast of South America, Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean is coming up. This GRI will apply to cargo transported in 20' and 40' Dry containers, including High Cube equipment and 40' Non-operative reefers.
